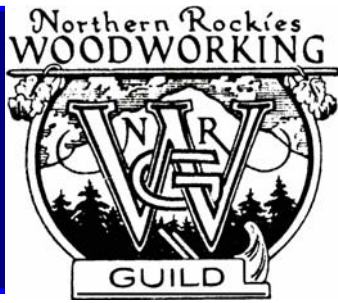

At the April meeting we tried a different format for the demo with hands on demo. This gives people a chance to try the techniques. Please give some feedback of what you thought of this format.

## April 2006 Meeting Minutes

- The April meeting was held on April 11th at the Bozeman High School wood shop. Treasurer George Stanislao reported a bank balance of \$1669.31. If you have not paid your dues for 2006 please contact George.
- At the meeting Jim Palakovich reported that he still had not received a price for the Powermatic lathe from Ken at 4 corners hardware. The price was estimated to be around \$2700 and it was decided that we should to ahead with the purchase ASAP. Jim agreed to submit the actual request for the money from the AAW. The hope is to get the lathe in before the school year ends. School is out from June 9th to around August 26th.
- Subsequent to the meeting Jim Palakovich reported to the lathe committee that he did receive a price of \$2650.00 FOB 4 corners for the 3520B. The lathe committee did proceed with the order and as of last Friday the lathe is on order. In addition to the great price Ken at 4 corners hardware gave us he also agreed to order the lathe and hold it until we got the money together. Jim expects the check from the AAW for \$800 to arrive in about 3 weeks. The grant is for \$1000 but they will send \$800 first then send the remainder after we send a copy of the receipt.
- **Now is the time to step up with donations** to help us take care of the purchase without depleting our treasury. At the previous meeting a motion was passed to keep a minimum balance of \$600 during this purchase. This leaves us **short by \$600.00** by the time we take \$1050.00 from the present bank balance and \$1000 from the AAW against the purchase price of \$2650.00.
- At the meeting several members raised their hands and said they would be willing to donate some money and later a couple of member suggested they would be willing to match the donations from the other members up to a limit. It should be easy for us to come up with the \$600.00.

- Gordon is still looking for donations of wood that can be used by the students for turning projects.
- More discussions about a possible guest turner. It is still strongly felt that we need to schedule a guest turner during a time when the students can observe also. The school schedule has the end of the year on June 9th with school starting around August 26th. It was decided to hold off on getting a demonstrator until after school is back in session. - Because of the school schedule it was decided to move the June meeting up one week to Tuesday June 6th.
- After the June meeting we will take the traditional summer break and skip meetings in July and August and resume in September.
