#### Penn State Industries Recalls Woodworking Jaw Chuck Systems Due to Laceration Hazard

This recall involves Penn State Industries CSCBARR5 quick-change jaw chuck systems used with woodworking lathes. The recalled jaw chuck systems are made of steel, are silver in color and measure about 3.875 inches in diameter.
